WORK IN A SMALL SKETCH BOOK FOR RESEARCH

TYPE UP TITLES OR NOTES FOR NEATNESS AND LEGIBILITY

TALK TO YOUR PEERS, SOMEONE AT HOME OR YOUR TEACHER

I NEED TO MANAGE MY TIME BETTER TO ENSURE I SPEND AT LEAST 6 HOURS WORKING

PLAN OUT YOUR WORK FIRST

COMPLETE 1 TASK PER WEEK AND TICK OFF WHEN EACH ONE IS COMPLETE

DON'T LEAVE IT UNTIL THE WEEK/ NIGHT BEFORE

THINKING AND PLANNING TIME SHOULD NOT BE MORE THAN 1 HR TO GIVE YOU 5 HRS PRACTICAL TIME
