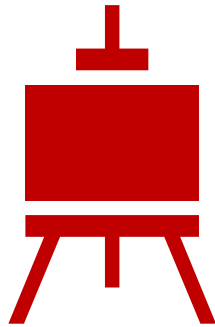

- Summative:** A04 Final outcome

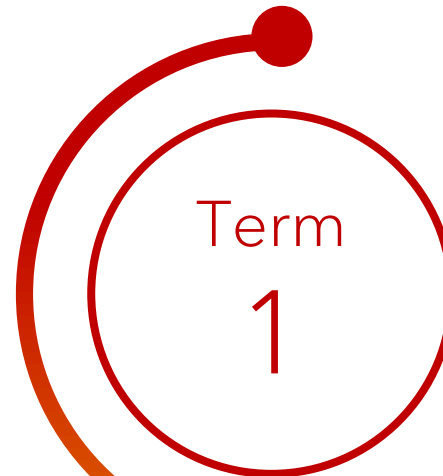
## Thematic Exploration and Development

Students will select a theme to explore, research and source artists, and produce analytical drawings from initial responses. They will document their artistic process, including successes and creative mistakes, and develop a range of studies and completed works. The term involves refining ideas, experimenting with materials and techniques, and creating mock versions of the final piece, leading to a thorough evaluation.



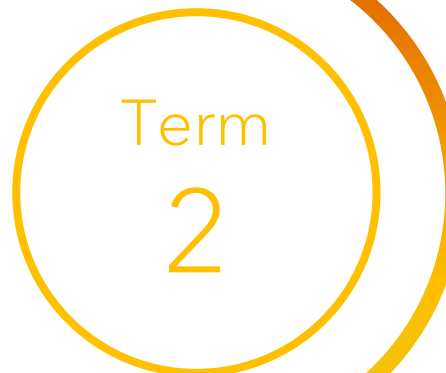
## How I'll be assessed...

## Developmental Studies and Final Outcome

Students will engage in developmental studies, experimenting with composition, materials, media, and techniques. They will merge artist techniques, create multiple development pieces, and upscale their work. The term includes planning essays, making comparisons using photographic terms, and preparing for a final composition through detailed contextual research and feedback.

## Final Outcome and Examination

Students will focus on producing a final outcome based on all contextual research, development, and techniques. They will develop their final design idea for the exam, complete a 15-hour exam piece, and submit Component 2. The term concludes with the submission of Component 1, ensuring all assessment criteria are met.
