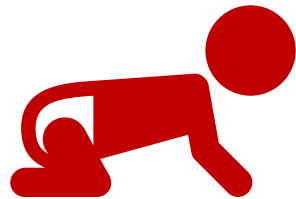

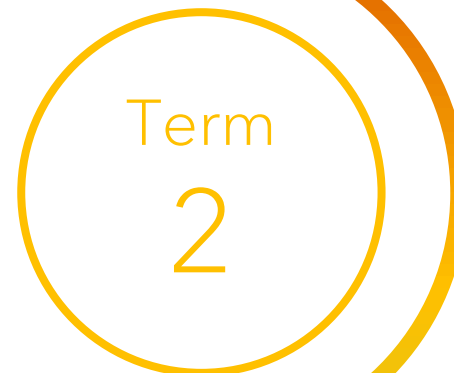
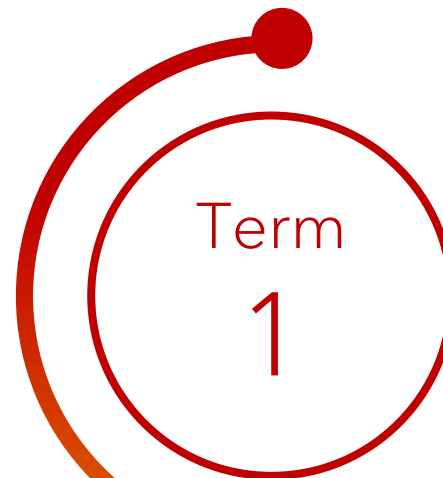
Unit R058: Create a safe environment and understand the nutritional needs of children from birth to five years)
