- The programme emphasises speaking and writing at sentence level, with assessments through baseline and unit tests to track progress.

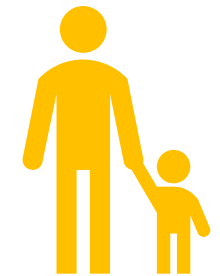
Programme Focus

- The Intermediate ESOL programme aims to enhance students' spoken and written communication skills with a focus on increasing confidence, independence, fluency, and spontaneity.



Vocabulary and Grammar

Speaking and Writing Skills

- The programme introduces producing written work of varying lengths using diverse grammatical structures and involves assessments, including baseline and unit tests.
